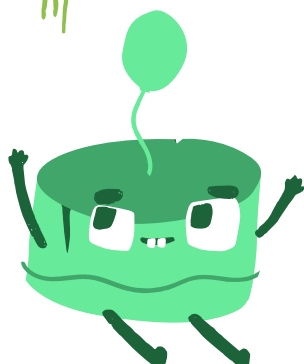
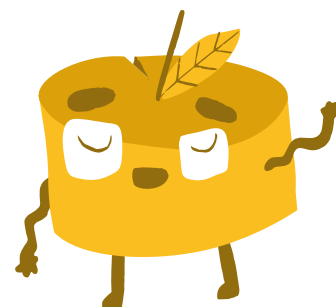


How to use this book



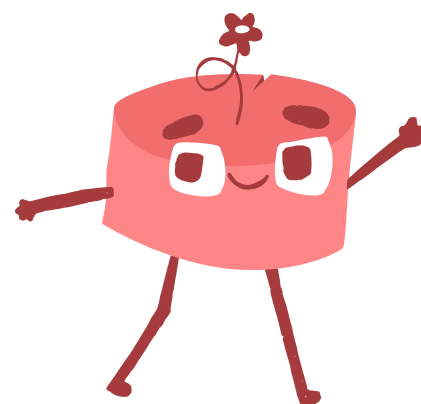

All the books listed throughout the activity booklet are also on the back cover, too, so they're all in one handy spot.



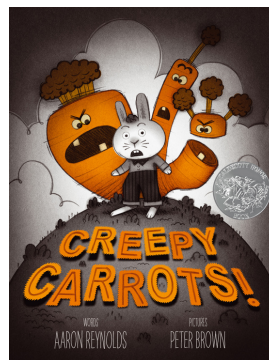
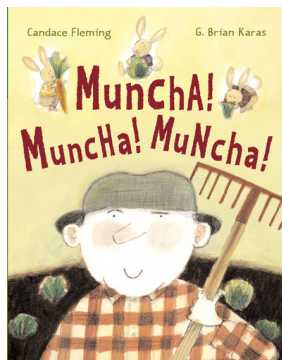
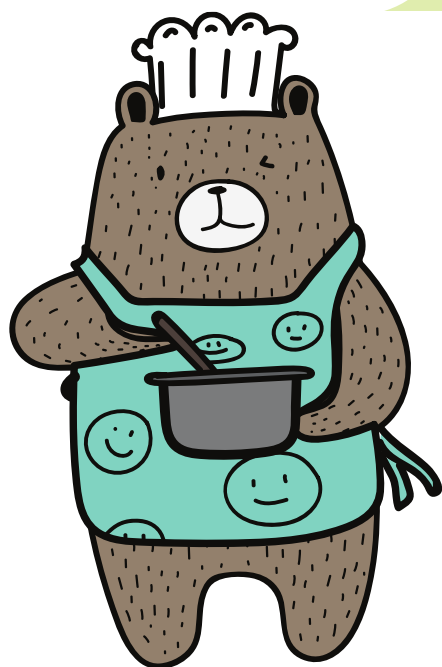

Family Fun Activity:

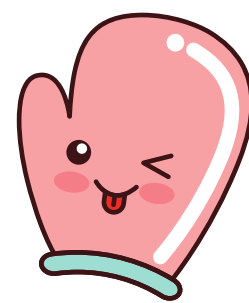
Whether you love tacos or your favourite food is something equally epic, learning to cook is a great summertime activity!

- 3 Time to cook! Enjoy the delicious meal you make together but don't forget that a good cook always helps to clean up afterwards!



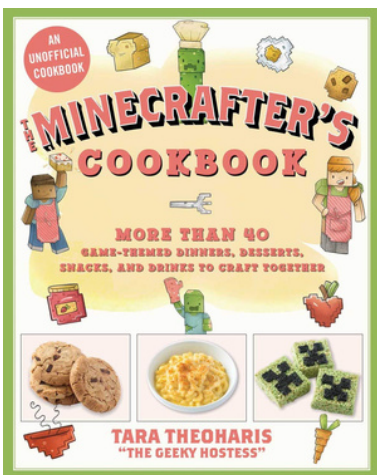
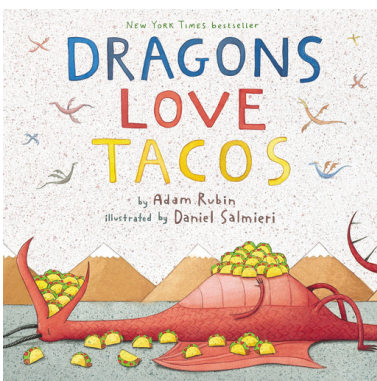

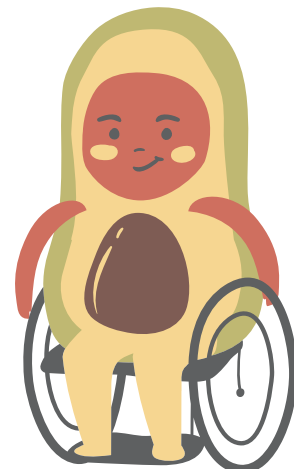
Family Fun Activity:

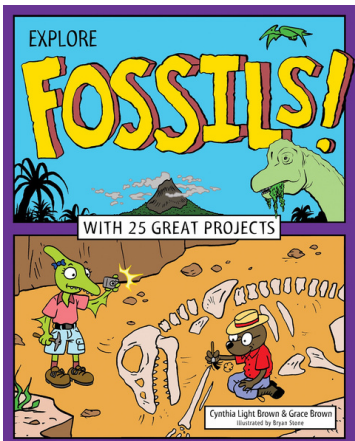
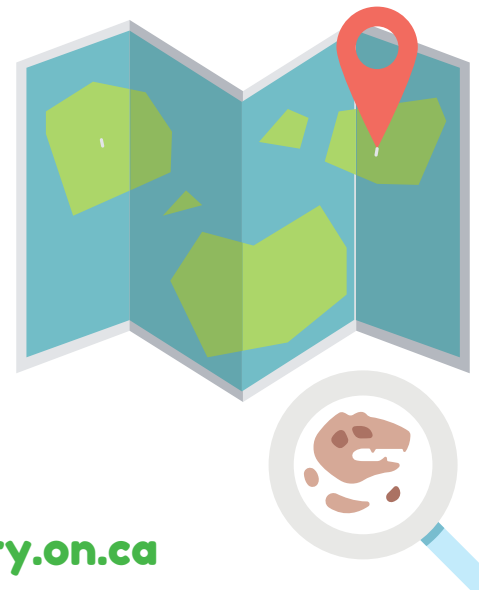


Family Fun Activity:

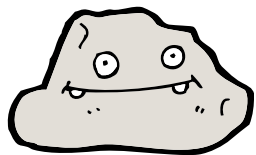

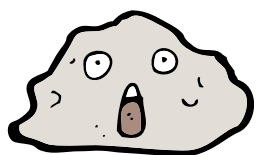
Make a painted pet rock!

You will need:

- a smooth rock
- paint (acrylic works best)
- paint brush
- decorations of your choice (e.g. googly eyes, feathers, felt, foam)
- glue to attach decorations



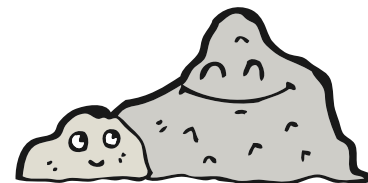
1 Paint your base colour. Let it dry and then add more colours, patterns, and designs! TIP: Paint with lighter colours first, then darker colours.



2 Give your rock a face! Try painting on eyes, a nose, a mouth. Maybe you want to turn your rock into an animal!



3 Glue on decorations of your choice. For example, if you designed your rock to look like a bird you might want to glue on some feathers or a beak. Let your imagination run wild and see what you come up with!



Use an empty tissue box to make a home for your pet rock!

Be creative! If you want to paint the outside of the box, it might be easier for the paint to stick if you glue torn-up bits of newspaper to the outside, then wait for it to dry. Make artwork for the inside walls, a chandelier for the ceiling, even a rug for the floor.

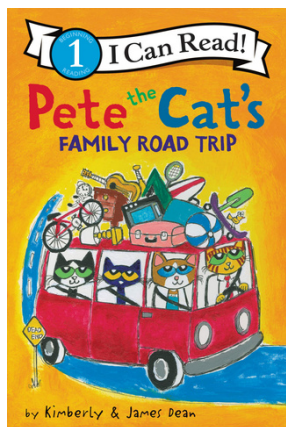

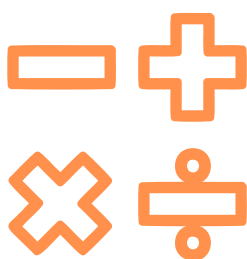

Why not create a family newspaper? You can do it digitally or using paper. Is there a mystery in the house to uncover? A feel-good story to report on? This is a great project to work on together!



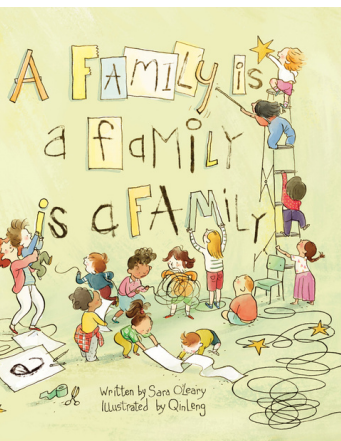

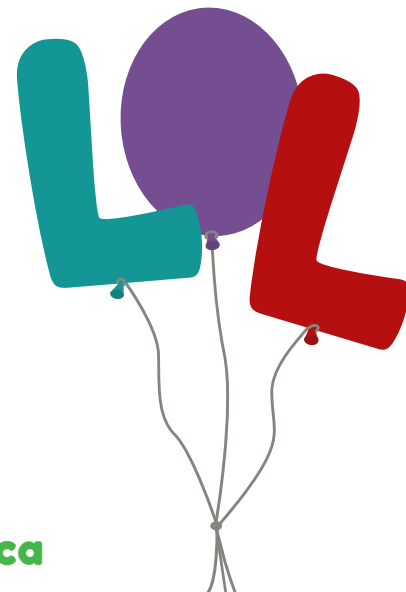
Family BONUS FUN

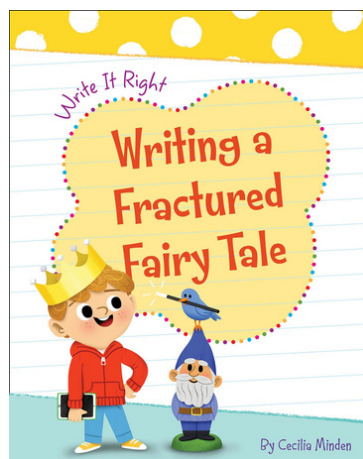
Family Fun Activity:
