


Dissect a Flower!




You will need:

- a flower
- your favourite drawing supplies
- something to help pull apart your flower, eg. toothpick, tweezers, scissors
- Examine your flower closely. What parts do you see? Review the Parts of a Flower diagram below to learn about the anatomy of a flower. Can you identify the parts of your flower just by looking at the outside?
- Draw a picture of your flower on the next page.
- Gently take apart (dissect) your flower by pulling all the parts away from each other. Can you identify the parts of your flower and label them on your drawing?

Parts of a flower:








Try identifying and labeling the parts of your flower using the diagram on the previous page!

Hug a tree.







Bird watch & draw







Rainbow Nature Search

You will need:


- a crayon

- Watch your leaf rubbing appear... and then try another one!










See a bug, draw a bug! How many bugs can you find / think of? Draw your 4 favourites!












Design your own beautiful butterfly using your favourite colours, shapes and patterns!
